High School aged volunteers are needed to be camp counsellors and activity support volunteers. More information about our volunteer positions can be found below. Hours volunteered can be used for the high school Christian Service requirement for graduation.

Volunteer Position Descriptions

Camp Counsellors

The camp counsellor will be responsible for supervising approximately 5 children from the time of drop off to pick up. The camp counsellor leads their group to all activity stations. The camp counsellor accompanies and supports children in all activities. The camp counsellor ensures that all children have a safe and enjoyable camp experience. There are usually 2 counsellors for each group of 5 – 7 children.

Activity and Support Camp Staff

High School volunteers may be needed to help support our Activity Leaders. If there are more than enough camp counsellors, high school volunteers could be asked to work with activity leaders. The activity stations are: kitchen, Faith Alive Band, arts and crafts, faith and games and parking and ground security.

CAMP VOLUNTEER RETREAT—Compulsory

All adult and high school volunteers will meet for a **retreat Sunday July 22nd**. It is compulsory for all adult and high school volunteers to attend this retreat at which time important camp information will be distributed which will include safety and security guidelines. Camp counsellors will have the opportunity to meet all activity leaders. More importantly, all volunteers will have the opportunity to meet each other and begin the important task of team building.
